<ul> <li>Tattoos</li> <li>Students are not permitted to display tattoos whether temporary or permanent</li> <li>This includes henna, jeweled embellishments, and/or stickers</li> </ul>	If a student has a tattoo that would be visible it must be covered by bandage, sleeve, or other school appropriate method
