



Student Dress Code: 2024-2025

Students at Washington Park Community School are expected to follow dress code standards as outlined in this policy. Students are expected to maintain an appearance that is not distracting to students, teachers, or the educational process of the school. Parents and children are equally responsible for the child's appearance and will be notified in writing about any changes to dress code. The school administration may require students to change any clothing that is deemed inappropriate. Please help your child adhere to the guidelines as listed below.

School administrators reserve the right to determine if students' attire is inappropriate and/or unsafe regarding any items that may not be listed below.

Shirts:

- **Style:** T-shirts, Polos, sweatshirts, button down, collared, or long-sleeved shirt
 - **Solid Color:** Black, Gray, White, Blue, Light Blue, Navy Blue, or Red
- **Patterns:** Striped, Polka-dots, Color blocks, or Plaid are OK

NOT PERMITTED:

- LOGOS, PRINT, or WORDS
- NO belly shirts or crop-tops
- NO tank tops, spaghetti straps
- NO oversized, bulky, or baggy shirts
- Must NOT be see-through
- NO neon colors, tie-dye, glitter, sequins, or other bright colors

Sweaters:

- **Style:** Cardigan, Pullover, or Zip-up
- **Solid Color:** Black, Gray, White, Blue, Light Blue, Navy Blue, or Red
- **Patterns:** Striped, Polka-dots, Color blocks, or Plaid

NOT PERMITTED:

- LOGOS, PRINT, or WORDS
- May NOT be oversized, bulky, or baggy
- Must NOT be see-through
- NO crop-tops or off the shoulder styles

*****Please note: Zip-up hoodies are permitted. HOODS MUST REMAIN OFF THE HEAD AT ALL TIMES INSIDE OF THE BUILDING**

Any non-compliance will result in a phone call home for a change of clothes, a request to leave the hoodie in the office until dismissal, and/or after school detention due to insubordination.

Pants, Shorts, Capris, Dresses, Skirts, and Belts

- **Style:** Dress pants, Khakis, Ankle pants, Joggers, Capris, Shorts, Gym Shorts, Yoga Pants, and Leggings

are all OK

- **Solid Color:** Black, Gray, Brown, Tan, Khaki, White, Blue, Navy Blue, or Red
- **Pants and shorts with a minimal pattern are OK** (example: single stripe down the side or ombre)
- **Belts:** Solid color as listed above- no embellishments

NOT PERMITTED:

- NO DENIM JEANS/ Ripped Jeans/ Jeans with holes
- LOGOS, PRINT, or WORDS
- NO see-through
- Shorts above the child's fingertips are unacceptable
- Must NOT be baggy or oversized, or sagging
- NO neon colors, embellishments, glitter, sparkles, and other bright colors

Shoes

- **Style:** dress shoes, tennis shoes, flats, boots, or sandals (must have enclosed back)
- Socks must be worn with appropriate shoe style
- Tennis shoes REQUIRED for participation in Physical Education class (all K-8 students)

NOT PERMITTED

- NO neon colors, embellishments, glitter, sparkles, and other bright colors
- NO flip-flops
- NO slides or other backless shoes
- NO "Heelies," hiking boots, or combat boots
- NO heels or platform shoes higher than 1 inch

Hair and Headwear

- Neatly groomed
- Natural hair color ONLY
- Hats, hoods, scarves, bandanas and other similar articles must be removed upon entering the building

NOT PERMITTED:

- **NO COLORED or UNNATURAL HAIR DYE OR HIGHLIGHTS including but not limited to: blue, purple, green, orange, burgundy, neon, or bright red**
- Facial hair is not permitted

Jewelry

- Piercing jewelry may be worn in earlobes only
- Must be reasonable size as to not pose a safety concern
- Students may wear appropriate necklaces, bracelets, and/or rings appropriate to learning environment
- **Smartwatches or other digital watches may be worn—but may not disrupt the learning environment; or used in any comprisable way that affects the child's learning process.**

NOT PERMITTED:

- Excessive jewelry distracting to the learning environment is NOT acceptable
 - noises, bright lights, or an excessive amount of necklaces, bracelets, and/or rings that affects the child's learning process

- Students are not permitted to display tattoos whether temporary or permanent
- This includes henna, jeweled embellishments, and/or stickers
