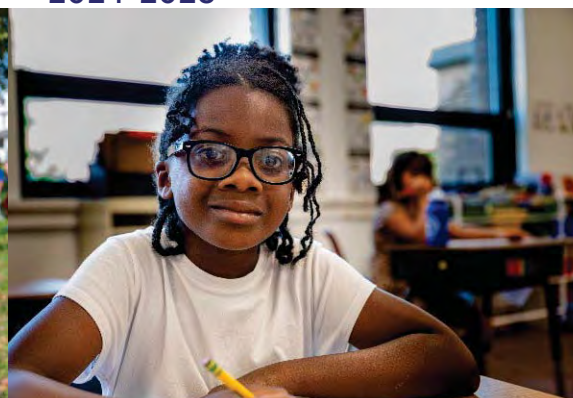

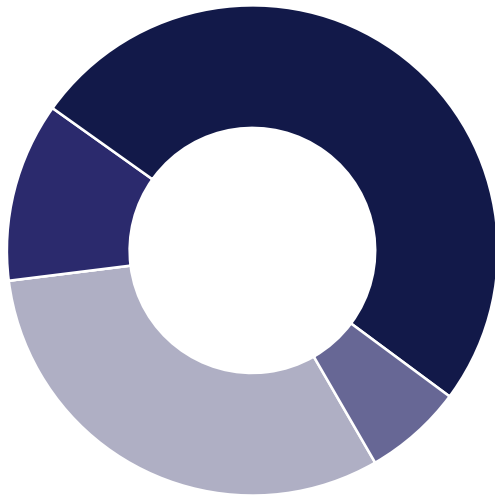

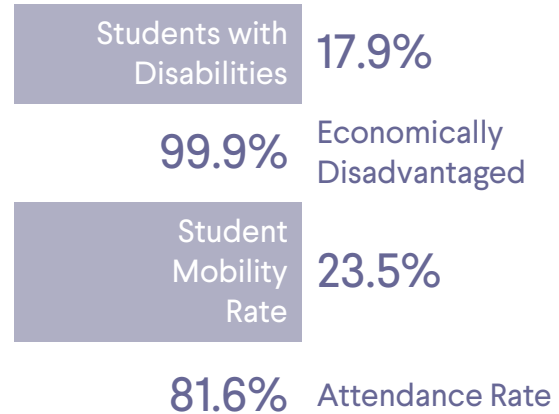

## Progress towards Goals

The percent proficient in ELA on the state assessment increased from 30.6% in SY2024 to 40.8% in SY2025.

The percent proficient in Math on the state assessment increased from 15.5% in SY2024 to 23.3% in SY2025.

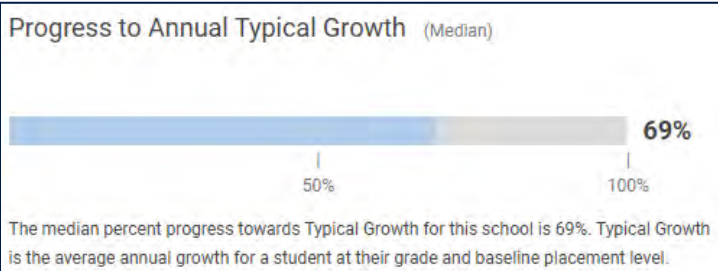

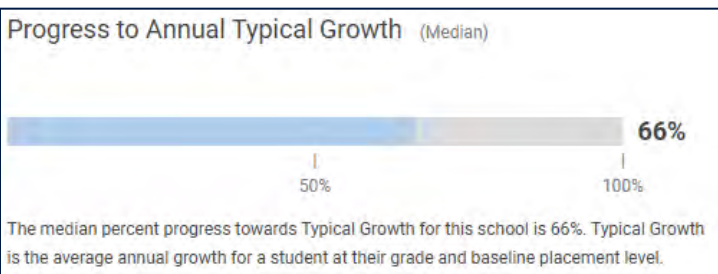

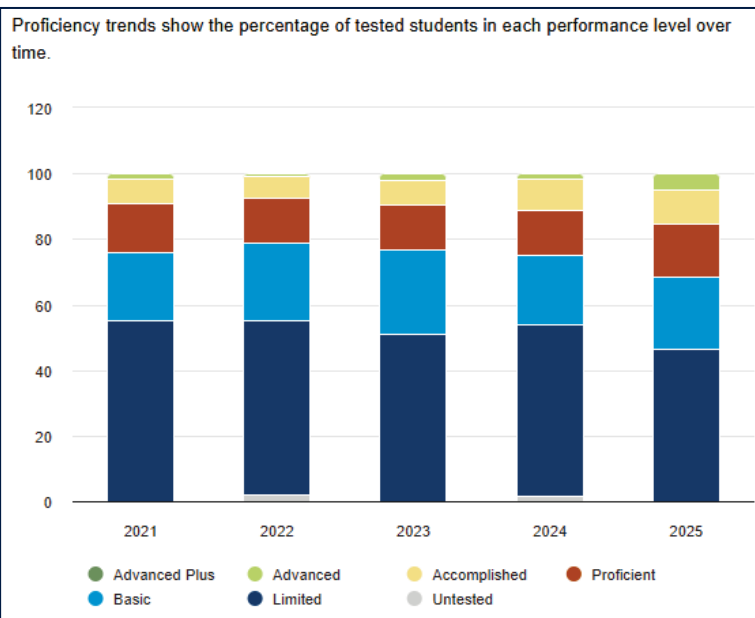
## iReady Data Reading
